What is the Community Hospital?

The Community Hospital (OdC) of Sezze is a hospitalization health facility of the territorial network that performs an intermediate function between the home and the hospital. Located in Via San Bartolomeo, on the second and third floors of the Sezze complex, the CB is an integral part of District 3 and caters to a population of about 55,000 inhabitants of the municipalities of the Lepini Mountains.

Its primary objective is to avoid improper hospital admissions and to promote protected discharges in places suitable for clinical stabilization and recovery of autonomy, as close as possible to the patient's home. The structure is barrier-free and has 20 beds, divided into rooms from one to four beds, all equipped with toilets equipped for non-self-sufficiency.

The structure is also equipped with common areas for socializing, a living area for eating meals and general shared services such as kitchen and laundry, designed to make the hospital stay as close as possible to the domestic dimension.

The Community Hospital of Sezze is open every day from Monday to Sunday 24 hours a day

Access Procedures and Admission Criteria

Access to the CB is on prescription from the General Practitioner, the Territorial Specialist or the Hospital Doctor for hospitalizations lasting up to 30 days.

Who can access?

The service is aimed at frail patients with chronic exacerbated diseases or clinically stable people from hospital wards who need a stabilization period before returning home.

Clinical Inclusion Criteria:

For reception, clinical stability is required verified through objective parameters, specifically a Clinical Instability Index (MEWS) with a score ≤ 2 and a Care Dependency Index (IDA) ≥ 2 .

“The Community Hospital is a place of proximity care, conceived as a bridge between the hospital and one’s home to ensure continuity of care and promote the recovery of autonomy in a safe environment close to one’s loved ones.”

Treatment Paths and Services Offered

The clinical activity is based on an **Individual Assistance Project (PAI)** that integrates nursing, medical and rehabilitation services. The rehabilitation staff deals with functional assessment and early mobilization programs, while simultaneously training the patient and caregivers in the use of aids to facilitate a safe return home.

The facility also provides access to basic diagnostic services, such as blood chemistry tests and ECGs, and manages complex therapies, including oxygen therapy and parenteral nutrition. Each pathway is supported by a **computerized clinical-care record** connected to the Electronic Health Record (EHR), ensuring that health information follows the patient at every stage of the treatment pathway.

Health Care & Nursing

It is the heart of the structure, guaranteed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

What we offer: Continuous surveillance, management of drug therapies, monitoring of vital parameters and management of complex devices (catheters, ostomies, oxygen therapy)

Team: The service is provided by 7-9 nurses (including the coordinator) and 4-6 Social and Health Workers (OSS)

Medical Assistance

Clinical responsibility is entrusted to a dedicated doctor who collaborates with General Practitioners (GPs).

Presence: Insured for 4.5 hours a day, 6 days a week.

Continuity: At night and on holidays, assistance is guaranteed by the Continuity of Care Doctors.

Rehabilitation and Functional Assistance

The structure has equipped rooms for motor activities.

Activities: Functional assessment, reactivation programs for early mobilization and training in the use of aids for the patient and their caregivers.

Diagnostics and Support

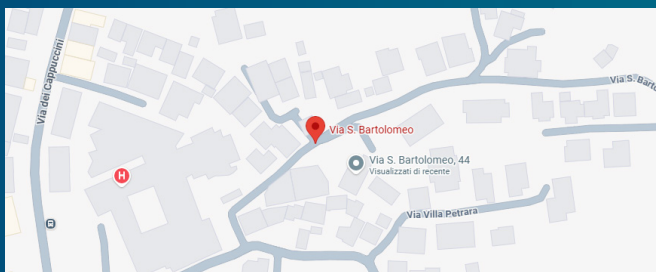
